Performance Outcomes Description/Improvement Percentages	Add surveillance ability to six new buses.	The surveillance cameras, installed in four buses, have achieved a performance outcome of at least 2% reduction in operating cost associated with claims against the City. To date, the high definition video has provided clear confirmation that the City was not liable for damage to personal property in two incidents and one accident claim occurring on City buses. Other benefits include storage capacity of 750 gigabytes, which is a 200% increase over the old system; retention of 90 days high definition video, versus the 60 days of lesser quality video stored by the old system; improved sound quality; a hand held viewer; user friendly software; responsive tech support and connect card compatibility. The buses that received all or partial PTMISEA funding for their camera systems are VIN No. 1N9MNACL8FC084011, 1N9MNACLXFC084012, 1GB6G5BG8E1172277, and 1GB6G5BG4E1172471.
